Where: Fort Casey State Park (on Whidbey Island) – 1290 Engle Rd. Coupeville, WA 98239.

When: Saturday February 26, 2022 @ 8:30 am to Sunday February 27 @ 9 am.

Requirements: Webelos or Arrow of Light rank and have adult chaperone(s) from your pack.

What to Bring:

- \$10 per scout/adult for food – Saturday lunch/dinner and Sunday breakfast (provided by Troop41) and campsite fees (This can be a check payable to Troop41 or Cash)
- Tent
- Sleeping bag/sleeping pad
- Mess kit/eating utensils
- Water Bottle
- Scouting 10 essentials.
- Scout Uniform (Class A for Flag Ceremonies and Class B for the rest of the time)

NOTE: Please be prepared for cold and wet weather for the weekend. A winter coat, layers of clothing and rain gear (Raincoat/pants or poncho) are recommended. Please reach out to us if you have questions/concerns.
